How do I find Volunteers and expand our volunteer base?

If you are having trouble finding volunteers outside board members ask: Have we actively looked for volunteers, are we using the talent of the people supporting our school? One way to accomplish this is send out a Parent Involvement/ Volunteer/ Talent survey to each parent. Tabulate all of the one's returned and USE them!!!

Unfortunately, when names appear on multiple sheets, those volunteers are called on all of the time. Here's a tip: Start from the "Z"s and have go backwards on lists- you would be surprised how happy people are to "finally be called" just a thought.

Most local units have a Volunteer form but they need to be update yearly. Below is wording that can be to you existing form.
